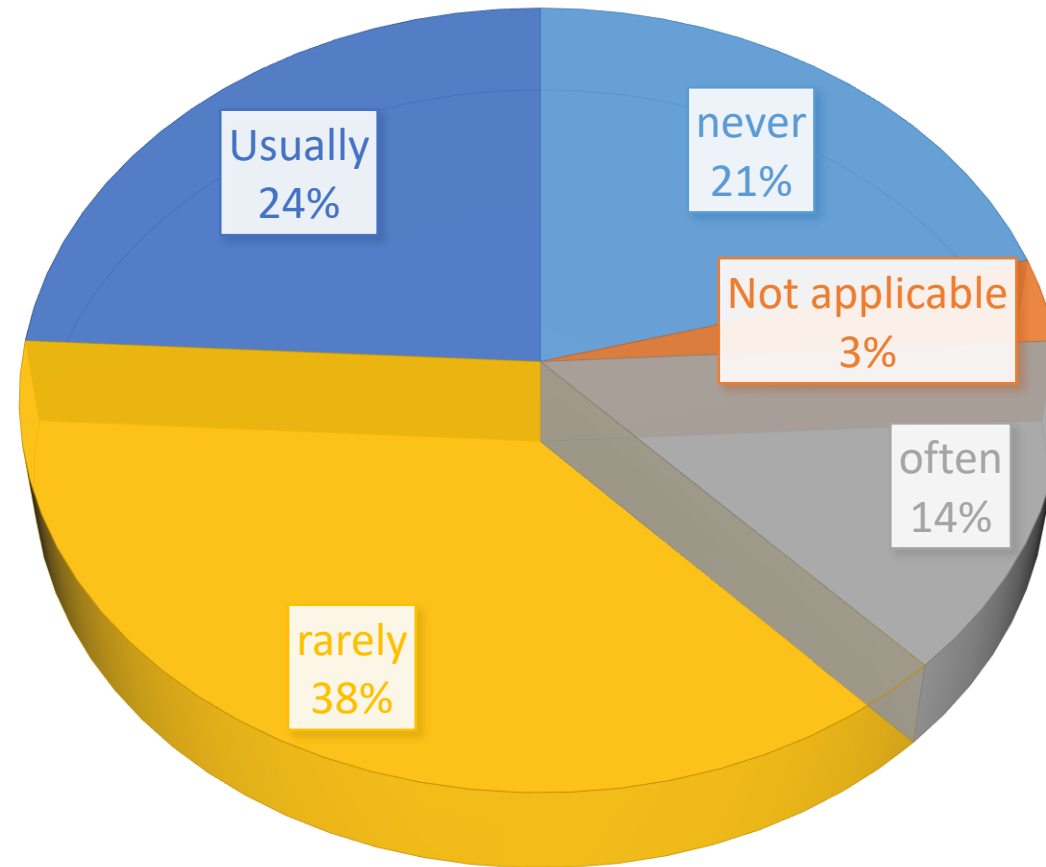

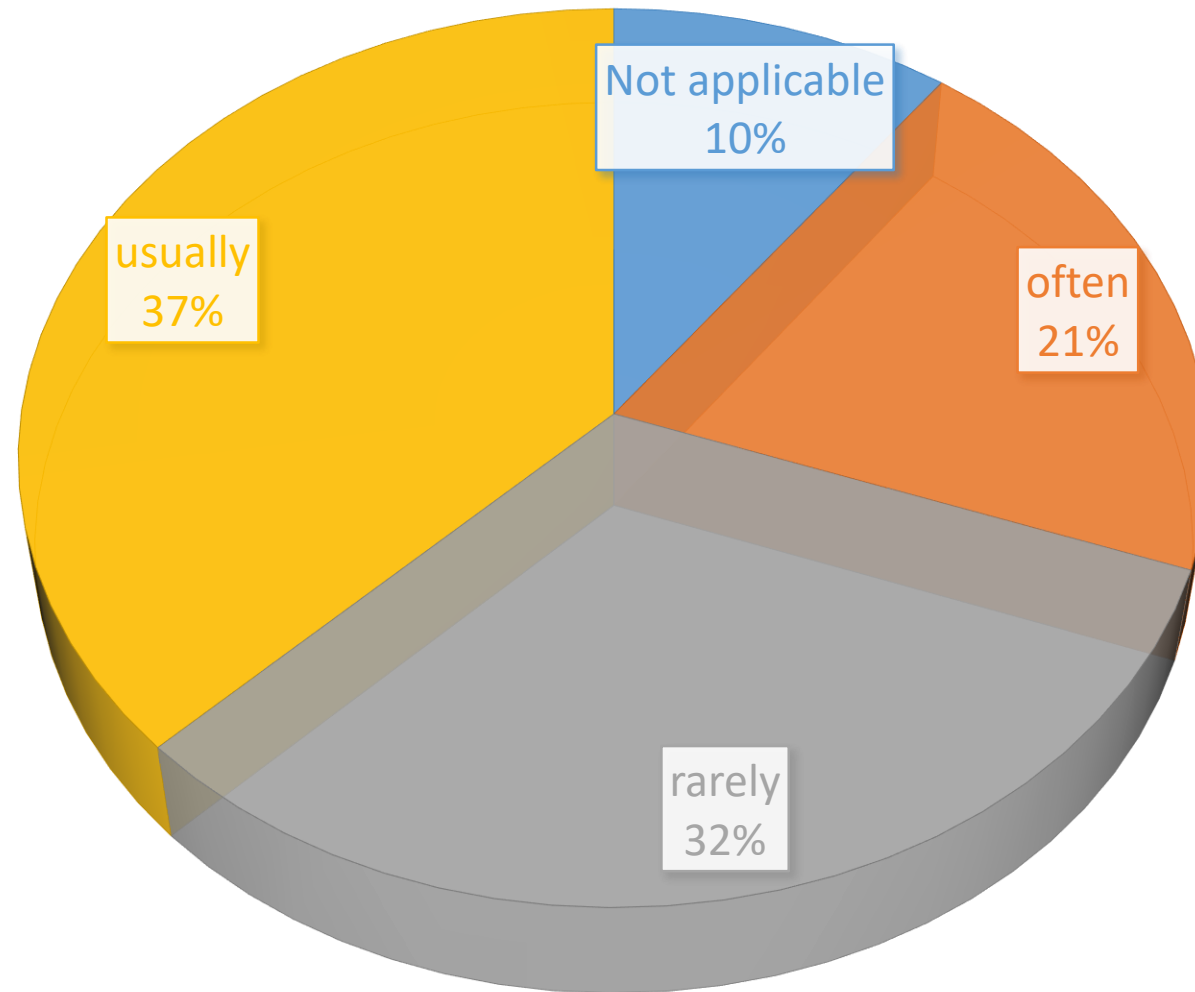

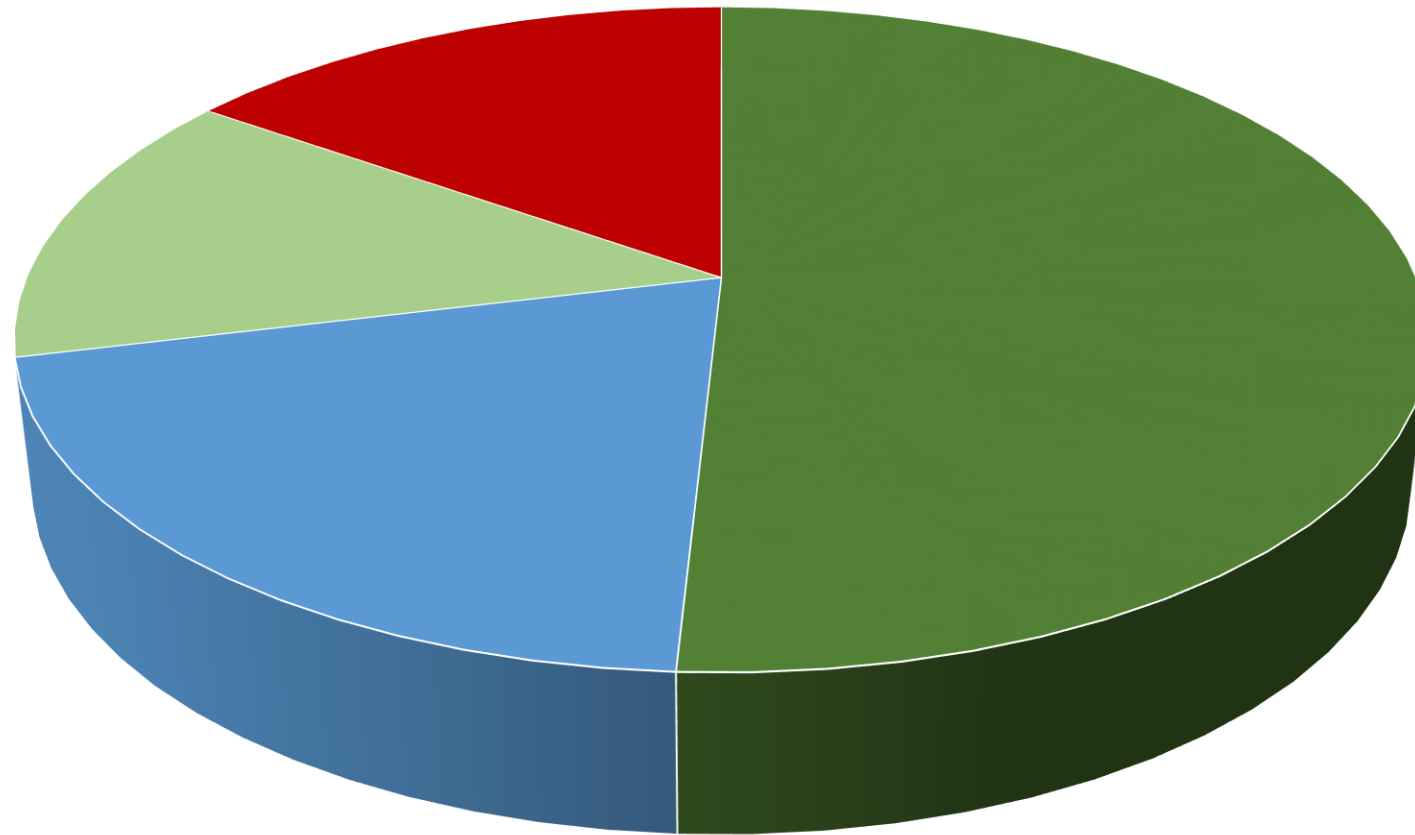

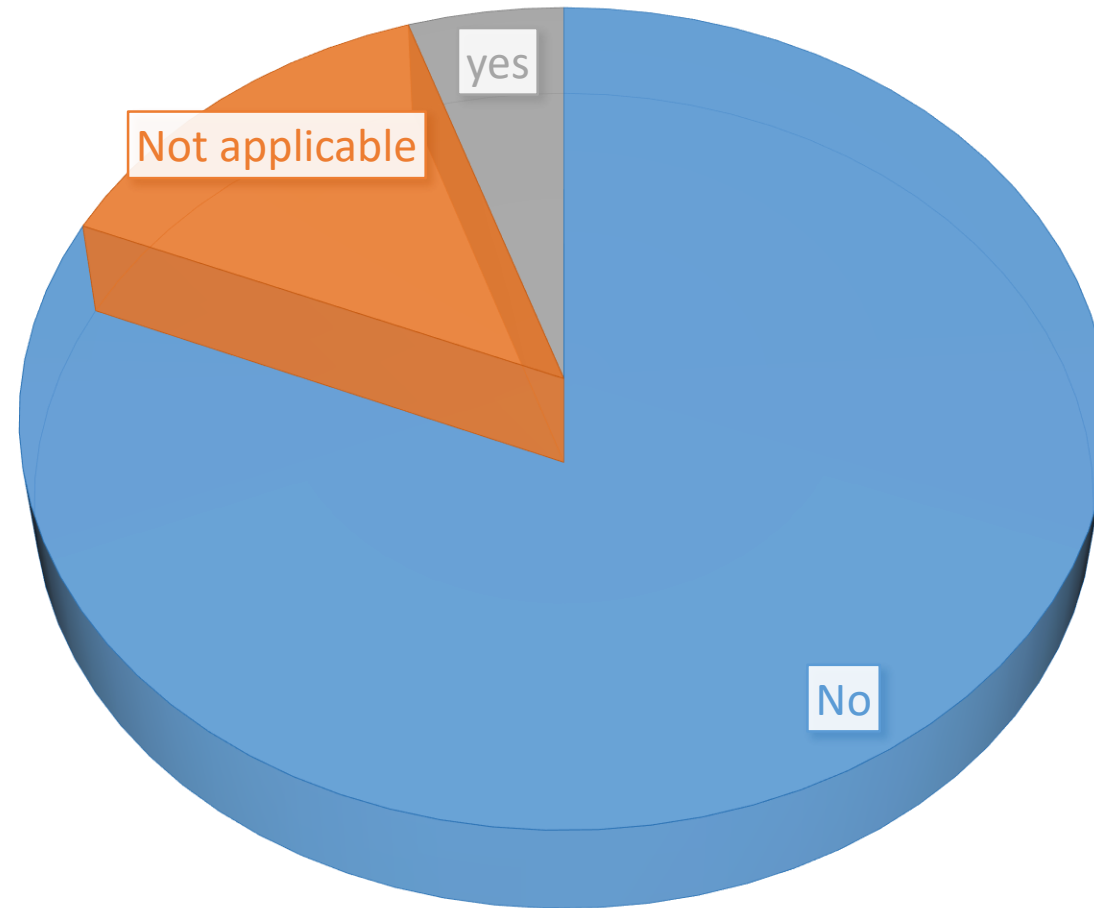


Do you normally receive some acknowledgement or receipt for sending your superannuation payment for locum work each month to the local office ?

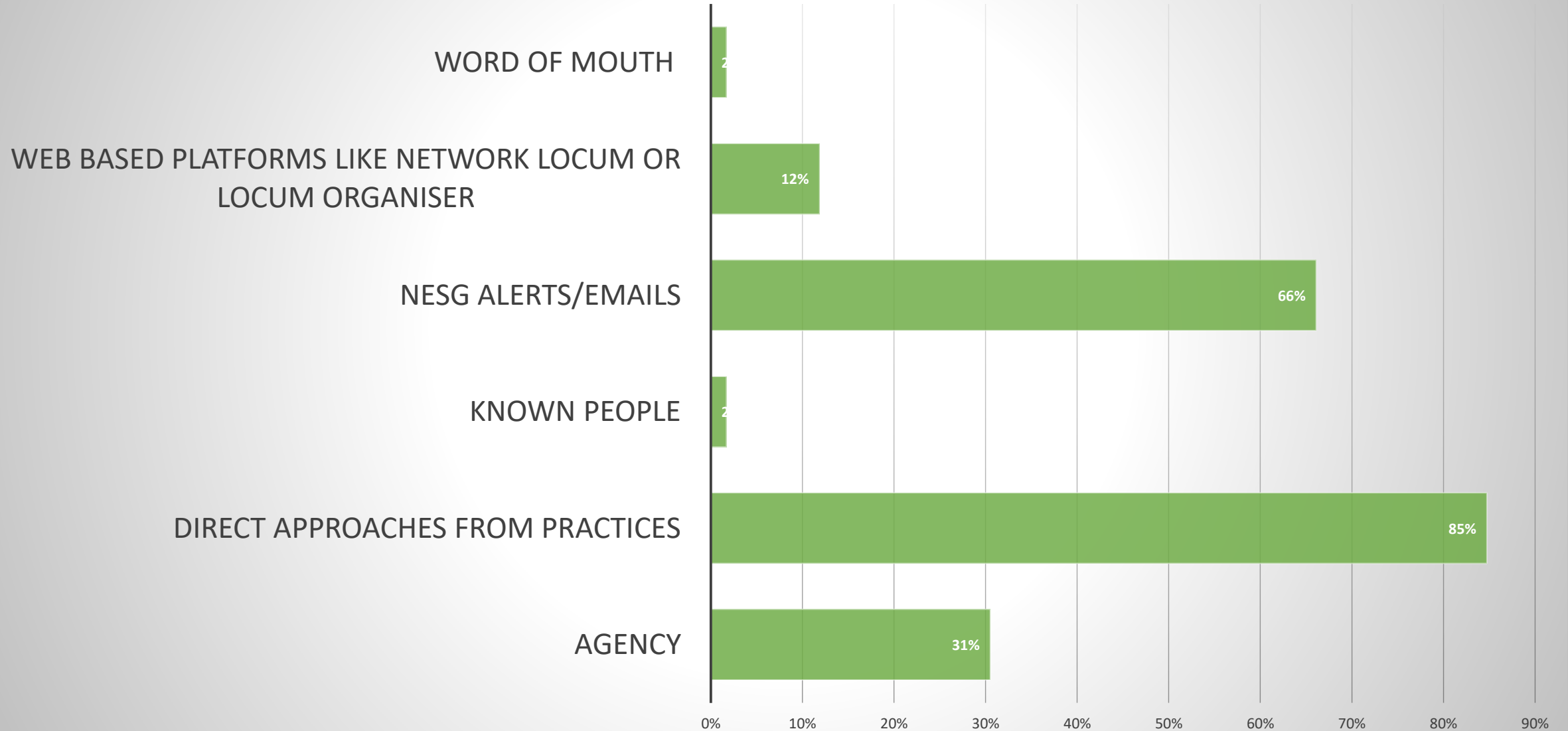

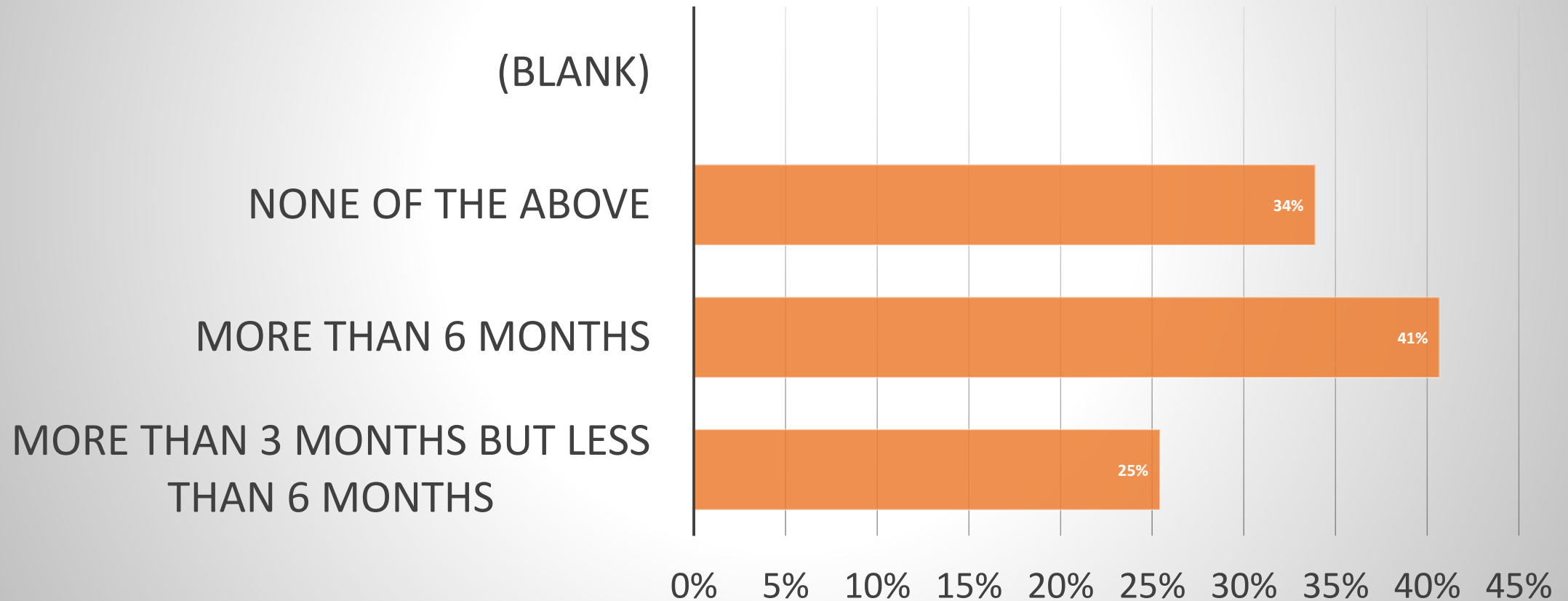

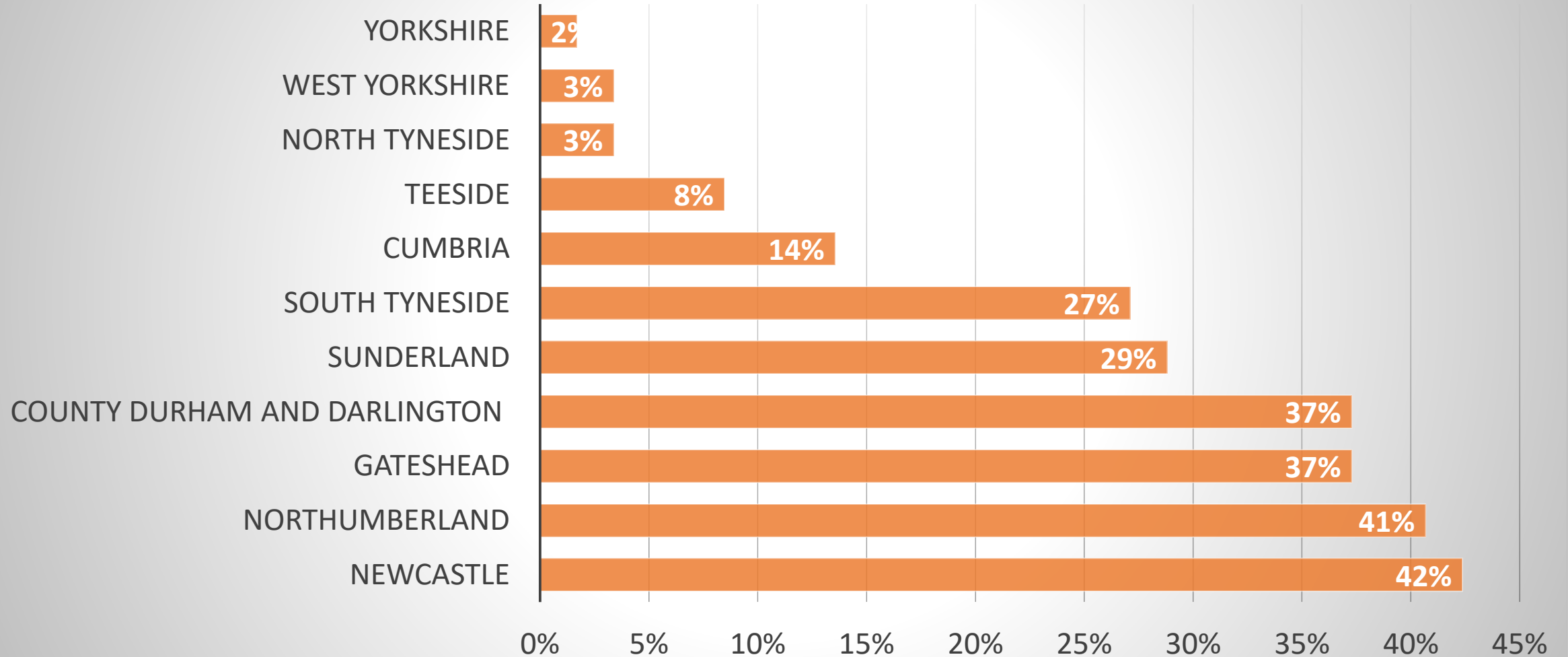
